Non-Essential

Non-essential Employee Designation shall be indicated in the employee's performance plan. The position is designated as a **non-essential** position and the employee's presence at work during an emergency is not required to assist agency and/or division in meeting its operational needs.

Have ever been told you were NON ESSENTIAL, not needed, have nothing to contribute?



1. In God's Kingdom we are all considered **ESSENTIAL**.

- a. Jesus came for all of us.
 - i. John 3:16
 - ii. 2 Peter 3:9

- b. His Spirit is made available to all of us.
 - i. Acts 2:17
 - ii. Acts 2:38

- c. Jesus commissioned ALL of Us to GO and share the Gospel.
 - i. Matthew 28:18-20
 - ii. Love one another

3. His Eye is on the Sparrow

Luke 12:6-7

In Jesus' day, you could buy 2 sparrows for a penny and 5 sparrows for 2 pennies. They were considered so insignificant (non-essential) the owner threw in the 5th one for free!!!

**YOU are more valuable than these!
 YOU are essential!**

Value is determined by the price one is willing to pay. Jesus loves you and paid the highest price for you --- His own life.

Remember little sparrow --- you too, were born to FLY!
